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## **Getting Started**

### **Decompress the downloaded file(s)**

To do this you will need a zip decompression utility such as WinZip(<http://www.winzip.com/>) or FreeZip (<http://members.ozemail.com.au/~nulifetv/freezip/>). If you use Windows XP, a decompression utility is built in.

Create a folder somewhere on your hard drive or your web server where you want to store the map files. Extract all files to that location.

### **The files downloaded will include:**

*NOTE: "map" is replaced with the country or state map you purchased.*

#### Map.ai

This is an Adobe Illustrator® file and can be edited using Adobe Illustrator. Adobe Illustrator is a product of Adobe® and is not included as part of this product. We do not provide technical support for Adobe applications.

#### map.htm

This is an html file that contains the image map code which will need to be copied and pasted into the HTML of the file on your website.

#### map.gif

The image files for each map. These should be placed in an "images" directory on your web server. There are four versions of the map included:

- Single color map
- Single color map with names
- Multi color map
- Multi color map with names

## **How to Embed Map Into Your Web Page**

Adding the imagemap to a web page is simple. First, open the .htm file provided using a web editor such as Dreamweaver. In the "code view" or "view code" mode, you will see the following html:

Copy and past that code into the html of the web page where you want the map to appear.

Right after that code, or somewhere between the <body> </body> tags of the html paste the imagemap code. The image map code resembles the following. It's unique to the dimensions of the map.

Once you've pasted the code into your web page, you will need to edit the links to point to the correct URL for each object (country, state or county). If you are viewing the code this is the section the reads `href = "filename.html"` (highlighted above) . You can view the `alt = "location"` tag to determine which object is which.

If you are using Macromedia Dreamweaver or other visual image map editing tool, you can select the object and set the URL and alternative text in the properties tool box.

### ***Resizing the Map***

You can resize the map to fit a specific area of your web page if you're using Macromedia Dreamweaver or other visual image map editing tool. To do this, first paste the code provided as instructed in the previous instructions. Then, in the design view of the html editor, select the image. Dreamweaver will put a selection box around the image. Hold down the shift key while placing the mouse on one of the corners. Hold the left mouse click and drag to resize. Holding the "Shift" key will keep the image proportional to the original.

### ***Replacing the Map***

For your convenience, we have provided multiple versions of the maps:

- Single color map without names (example: map\_single\_nonames.gif)
- Single color map with names (example: map\_single\_names.gif)
- Multi color map without names (example: map\_single\_nonames.gif)
- Multi color map with names (example: map\_single\_names.gif)

*"map" is replaced with the state, country name*

Because all maps have been saved using the same size/scale you can simply replace the file name in the following code.

**NOTE:** Make sure you use the correct path to the image file. By default we have mapped all images to an "images" directory. If you host the map image elsewhere you will need to edit the `src=""` in the HTML to point to the correct location.
